**Session Title:** A Fluid Activity Guide Based Approach to the Security Change

**Abstract:** King County recently replaced a paper-based security request form with a simplified, guided request process that reduces the customer wait time from 7 days down to less than 1. The request and approval process are managed within PeopleSoft using fluid-based components and activity guides. In addition to storing security settings by employee, the new design also supports storing security by position. This allows HR administrators and security officers to configure security for an employee even before they are hired, allows the settings to be re-used as employees transfer to new positions and greatly reduces the overall number of security requests.

There are many groups lined up to go next! This technology will become the Port's standard for timeclock functionality and we are so proud to have pioneered the way!"
